RPM Digital Print Ltd. is committed and fully supports those responsible forest management practices that both protect biodiversity and ecosystem integrity and result in long-term social and economic benefits to human communities.

It is the policy of RPM Digital Print Ltd. to wherever possible purchase paper and board produced from forests independently certified as well-managed, with the objective of having as many of RPM Digital Print Ltd's products FSC[®] certified as possible, given current market conditions.

It is the policy of RPM Digital Print Ltd not to be directly or indirectly involved in the following activities:

- Illegal logging or the trade in illegal wood or forest products;
- Violation of traditional and human rights in forestry operations;
- Destruction of high conservation values in forestry operations;
- Significant conversion of forests to plantations or non-forest use;
- introduction of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations;
- Violation of any of the ILO Core Conventions, as defined in the ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work, 1998.

As a member of The Group Scheme Ltd, a group scheme certified by BM Trada (an FSC accredited certification body), RPM Digital Print Ltd can offer FSC 100%, FSC Mix and FSC Recycled paper and board, thus giving its customers the freedom to use an environmentally sound substrate of their choice.

RPM Digital Print Ltd's Chain of Custody Procedures will operate in accordance with the requirements of the FSC Standard for Chain of Custody Certification (FSC-STD-40-004 -V2-1).

The commitment of RPM Digital Print Ltd. to the use of material from certified sources is communicated to all personnel and subcontractors and is available to the suppliers, customers, and other interested parties via the RPM Digital Print Ltd website.
